

Imitation of Christ Presentations

The *Imitation of Christ* presentations by Jerry Tritle will continue following the Coffee Klatsch at 9:50 a.m. on the Feb. Feb. 19 and Feb. 26.

Gospel Reflection

Today's Gospel offers a contrast to many of the messages we hear in our society today. If we were to accept uncritically the "get ahead" messages of our culture, we would think that happiness means having money, being successful, and having many possessions.

In this way, we are not unlike the people who heard Jesus teach on the day that he taught the Beatitudes. They too associated happiness with possessions and success.

The Beatitudes in Luke's Gospel, however, takes things one step further. Not only will we not find happiness through the "get ahead" messages of the world, but relying upon these messages will cause us harm.
