Beloved in Christ,

Thank you for your prayers and support for the Elect and the candidates for full communion with the Catholic Church. The Elect have their first scrutiny today (Sunday). The scrutinies are always on the third, fourth and fifth Sundays of Lent and provide milestones for formation heading toward the Easter Sacraments.

This Tuesday, March 25, is the Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord. Both of our schools will participate in Mass. This solemnity marks some very profound mysteries for the Christian Faith:

- It is the beginning of the life of Jesus, so Christmas is in nine months.
- It marks the beginning of His priesthood and victimhood.
- It marks the mystery of the Incarnation, God in human flesh. Because of this we will genuflect in the Creed where we normally bow. This gesture is also done on Christmas.

• It marks the mystery of the Hypostatic Union. In the one person of Jesus Christ, there are two natures: Human and Divine. God never had a body before the Annunciation, but he does now and will for all eternity in the person of Jesus Christ.

Even though Annunciation celebrates these amazing mysteries of our Faith, it is not a holy day of obligation. Moreover, this solemnity is never on a Sunday, Holy Week or Easter Week, so it gets moved about 17 percent of the time. We will have Mass at Mary, Help of Christians at 7:45 a.m, St. Brigid at 8 a.m., and St. Luke at 8:30 a.m.

Behold, I am the HANDMAD of the Lord Luke 1:38

Please keep my Family Leadership Team in your prayers this week. On Tuesday and Wednesday, we will be participating in a two-day on-site retreat for the Beacons of Light process, focusing on the culture of our Family of Parishes. The team consists of Fr. Ambrose, Fr. Blenman, Deacon Mark Danis, Dr. Josh Englefield, Brian Sticka, Heather Ayers, Brett Poling, and myself. As a reminder, Beacons helps us move our parishes from maintenance to mission, eventually becoming one canonical parish with six active churches. As anticipated, the debriefing of the financial review with the representative of the Archdiocese went very well. It was typical of my past review experiences, deeming us to be good stewards of our resources and ready to do even better with implementing more of the Archdiocese's recommended best practices.




