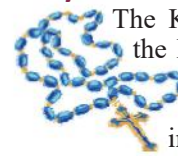

Need Donations for Refrigerator

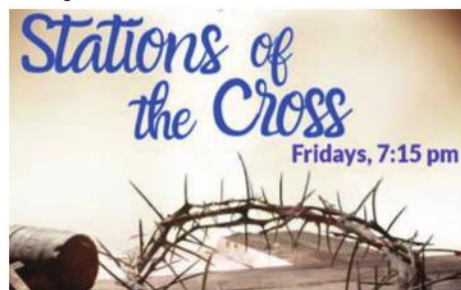

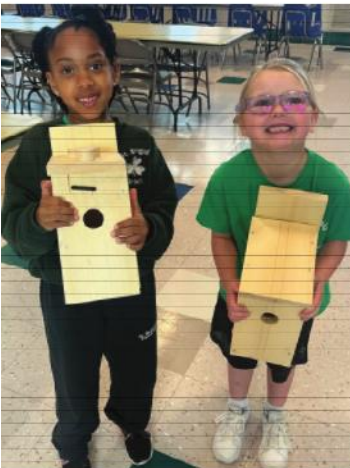
