



#### ON THE COVER

Bishops of the Church composed a Mass in honor of the Trinity to counter the Arian heresy that spread in the 4th century. One reason it was later placed after Pentecost Sunday was to align it with the time of ordinations.


the National Eucharistic procession (see updated schedule below) making its way to Indianapolis for the National Eucharistic Congress.

Members of the St. Michael Family can now choose to receive notification of funerals for fellow parishioners via email or text. Notices


will only be sent when the deceased's family grants permission to send them and notifications will include a link to online obituaries when available.
