Beloved in Christ,

September 15 is also known as Catechetical Sunday. It is an opportunity for the reminder that parents are the first educators of their children in the faith. Catholic schools, PSR, CCD, PRP, etc., do not replace, but rather partner with parents in educating their children in the Faith. During the Rite of Baptism, parents are charged three times to be the first and best teachers of the faith to the child they are presenting for the sacrament.

Catechetical Sunday also gives us an opportunity to pray for Archbishop Schnurr, our chief catechist. He continues to receive chemotherapy as treatment for cancer with only minor side effects, thanks be to God.

Speaking of the Archbishop, he will lead us in the Rosary today (Sunday) at 2 p.m. behind Mama DiSalvo's Restaurant. Please plan to join us in praying for an end to abortion.

Then at 3 p.m. Sunday, I look forward to seeing everyone at St. Luke's parish picnic.

This Tuesday, September 17, we observe the memorial of St. Robert Belarmine. Along with St. Albert the Great, he is a secondary patron of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati.

Looking ahead, all the parishes in the Archdiocese of Cincinnati count everyone attending Sunday Masses and Saturday vigils each weekend of October. This gives a consistent annual comparison to study trends. Tell a buddy, bring a friend to Mass in October!
