

Beloved in Christ,

Archbishop Casey will celebrate the Chrism Mass 3 p.m. this Tuesday (April 15) at the Cathedral Basilica of St. Peter in Chains. Parishioners are welcome to participate in this unique Holy Week liturgy rich in theological and pastoral significance.

Many of the faithful are accustomed to participating in daily Mass. Even though we cannot have Mass on the mornings of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday, we will still gather for **Lauds**. Sometimes called Morning Prayer, it is from the Liturgy of the Hours, the Church's official prayer of each day. Easy-to-follow worship aids will be provided. See the times for the liturgies below.

I provided a reminder last week about the Paschal Triduum: Good Friday is an obligatory day of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding from age 14 onward. Members of the Eastern Catholic Churches are to observe the particular law of their own Church.

Those excused from fast and abstinence outside the age limits include the physically or mentally ill, including individuals suffering from chronic illnesses like diabetes. Also excluded are pregnant or nursing women. In all cases, common sense should prevail, and ill people should not jeopardize their health by fasting.

If possible, the fast on Good Friday continues until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily his Resurrection.

I will offer the blessing for the food of the first meal of Easter in St. Dominic Chapel on Holy Saturday at 1 p.m.



LITURGICAL COLORS



Although we are still in our last days of the Lenten season, today we usher Holy Week in with a color change.

Today is Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord, so we appropriately switch to red for the blood and Passion of our Lord. Lent will end this week when the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday begins. This Lenten ending begins the Sacred Triduum. We mark this beginning and ending by shedding our Lenten purple for solemn white. This is the day we celebrate the institution of the priesthood and the institution of the Holy Eucharist. White is the appropriate color for Sacramental celebrations. After the Blessed Sacrament is processed and adoration begins, the church and altar will be stripped of the white and left naked, just as Christ was left naked on the cross. The Good Friday Passion of the Lord celebration will be marked with the bare altar, but red vestments again for the passion of Christ. Saturday, though, the church will be completely transformed for the Easter Vigil. After the starkness of Lent, we will be greeted by a beautifully decorated church in joyful, triumphant white, regal gold and a kaleidoscope of newly blooming spring flowers—signs of Christ's resurrection and victory over death.






